The 4-H Fashion Revue Contest will be held on **Monday, March 9, 2020**, in the Extension Meeting room at the **County Government Center in Woodstock**. We will also have a Fashion Show (for fun - not judged) during 4-H Share-the-Fun show on Sunday, March 15 (snow date March 22) at Zion Lutheran Church in Edinburg. This contest is for non-sewers. This means the outfit can be purchased, borrowed, or something you already own. If you have sewn your own outfit, there is a category for that – please let Carol know if you need to be in that category.

- bring your outfit to the contest on March 9 on a hanger and change into it just before you go in for judging
- bring in a folder:
 - Consumer Comparison Worksheet
 - Written Commentary
 - Photo of the outfit
 - Up to date project book
- judges will review the folder you brought with the project book and other forms first
- judges will examine the construction of the outfit – before you put it on.
- you will then model the outfit for the judges. They will ask questions.
 - after you have met with the judges, you will have time to practice modeling for the fashion show. The fashion show at Share-the-Fun will not be judged. All judging will take place on March 9.
